## NOVEMBER IS ROTARY FOUNDATION MONTH!

Guest Speaker: Stephanie Kuta, from the Rotary Foundation—some facts:

- Half of the world's population lives on \$2 a day
- \$1 will pay for 2 vaccines for polio
- Last year, Rotarians raised \$114 million for annual programs
- \$113 million was awarded (1/2 for matching grants, 1/2 for ambassadors, peace scholars, etc.)
- 4 countries are left in the world to eradicate polio: Pakistan, Afghanistan, India and Nigeria (PAIN)
- Rotary funds a 2-year Master's degree program in peace and conflict resolution, with 60 scholars annually. A new goal for the program is to raise 95 million by 2015 to endow the program
